

Dr. Lucia Parlato is Full Professor of Criminal Procedure at the University of Palermo (Italy), Department of Law. Her research interests cover: victims' protection; the right of defence; diversions tools; and digital evidence. She has received various fellowships (DAAD, MPI, etc.) and has been spending several research periods at the Max Planck Institute in Freiburg since 2001. Thanks to her international academic upbringing, she has developed a rich comparative approach and a special attention to supranational sources. She is the author of two books, respectively, on *La rifusione delle spese legali sostenute dall'assolto* (2018, Padova) and *Il contributo della vittima tra azione e prova* (2012, Palermo). Among the numerous papers she has published, the most recent focus on: online investigations; the particular tenuousness of the offence; the probation; victims' vulnerability; and migrants' rights in criminal proceedings. Since 2020 she has been teaching in international online courses organized by the University of Berkeley. She has been also collaborating with other foreign universities: among these, the University of West Bohemia and the Universities of Vienna, Passau, and Bremen.
